- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "Montana to secede from the Union"
- 2
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:
- 4 Section 1: Montana will sever all economic, political, and diplomatic ties with the villainous
- 5 United States of America.
- 6 Section 2: All state highway patrol, police, sheriff, army National Guard, air National Guard, and
- 7 all other defense units will remain intact, under the command of the Provisional Government.
- 8 Section 3: Martial law will be enforced until the initial violence and confusion is brought to an
- 9 end.
- 10 Section 4: A feudal system will be established; all non-land owners will be deemed peasants
- 11 (except those that possess a profitable skill, those that do will be made merchants) land owners
- 12 will be given large plantations, merchants will peddle their wares, and peasants will tend the
- 13 plantations of the land owners. Those owning land will be given power settle all political issues
- 14 through duels and all peasants shall be under control of the land owners
- 15 Section 5: A large wall will be erected along all borders of Montana, and anyone who isn't a land
- 16 owner will not be allowed to leave Montana.
- 17 Section 6: Funds for the wall will be taken from the general fund and built with peasant labor.
- 18 Section 7: All those that possess firearms, and that aren't land-owners, will have them
- 19 repossessed by the government.
- 20 Section 8: A sort of esoteric law enforcement task force will be formed to investigate and arrest
- 21 all those who are believed to be traitors to the state, revolutionaries, and spies.
- 22 Section 9: This bill shall go into affect after passage.
