1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL ELEMENTARY

2 STUDENTS LEARN A FOREIGN LANGUAGE."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 Section 1: All schools in the state of Montana shall offer at least one mandatory foreign  
6 language, to be taken from first to sixth grade.

7 Section 2: Three years of successful completion of a foreign language will be required of all  
8 Montana elementary students. Any student moving into Montana from out of state will be  
9 required to complete three years of at least one foreign language.

10 Section 3: This bill will go into effect the beginning of the 2007-2008 school year.
