A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "An act to make recycling required."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1: Recycling will be required in all of Montana's homes and business in an effort to preserve the natural resources of the country as well as the cleanliness of Montana.

SECTION 2: Montana citizens who neglect this act will be fined \$10 dollars on first offense, \$30 on second offense, \$40 on third offense, and so on.

SECTION 3: All recycled items will be picked up by garbage trucks on usual garbage rounds. Then the bags to be recycled will be separated from the garbage and taken to separate facilities.

SECTION 4: Enforcement of this bill will be done by the Enforcement Division of the Department of Environmental Quality.

SECTION 5: Recycled bags will be white or clear, while garbage bags will be black so that the difference can be made between the two.

SECTION 6: Effective date: This bill will go into effect exactly six months after the date the bill is passed.
