1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "ALTERNITIVE ENERGY INCENTIVES"

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE 2005 YMCA MONTANA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

3 **Section 1 Intent:** To provide monetary incentives, in the form of tax credits, to the residents
4 of Montana to participate in alternative energy sources, in an effort to conserve the natural
5 resources and environment of Montana.

6 **Section 2 Action:** The passage of the bill "Alternative Energy Incentives" will:
7 Provide tax credits amounting to five thousand dollars, to those Montana residents who
8 participate in the private alternative energy sources. Those participating in solar, wind and
9 hydroelectric energy sources will be eligible for the above mentioned tax credits.

10 **Section 3 Funding:** Funding will be provided by the United States Federal Government.

11 **Section 4 Enforcement:** No enforcement is necessary for this bill.

12 **Section 5 Enactment:** This bill will go into effect upon the start of the next fiscal year.
