1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REVISE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION
2 PROCEDURES; AMENDING SECTION 13-25-104, MCA."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE 2007 YMCA MONTANA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 **Section 1 Intent:** To help ensure that future presidents of the United States will best
5 represent the people of the United States, by requiring Montana’s presidential electors to
6 vote for the presidential candidate that receives the most votes in the national popular vote.

7 **Section 2 Action:** Section 13-25-104, MCA, is amended to read:

8 “**13-25-104. Meeting and voting of electors.** (1) The electors shall meet in Helena at 2
9 p.m. on the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December following their election.

10 (2) The electors shall vote by separate ballots for one person for president and one for
11 vice president of the United States.

12 (3) The electors shall cast their ballots for the persons who received the highest number of
13 votes for president and vice president of the United States, respectively, in the most recently
14 conducted general elections in the ~~state of Montana~~ states of the United States of America,
15 which will include those conducted in the District of Columbia.”

16 **Section 3 Funding:** No funding is necessary for this bill.

17 **Section 4 Enactment:** This bill will become effective immediately upon passage.
