1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "THE AMSTERDAM ACT": AN ACT TO INCREASE THE
2 CONTENTMENT AND ECO-FRIENDLINESS OF MONTANA'S CITIZENS.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 Section 1: The Amsterdam Act is an act that includes many behaviors that will ultimately lead to
7
8 a more eco-friendly and healthy Montana.
9

10 Section 2: All citizens in Montana capable of riding bikes shall ride a bike to and from work or
11
12 During the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, and October, if their commute
13
14 is approximately three miles or less and I they feel the weather is appropriate.

16 Section 3: Persons having to carry an object more than 25 lbs. or another person more than 25
17
18 lbs, or an object longer than 4 feet may use a car during these months.

20 Section 4: Every citizen in Montana shall make an effort to tolerate differences and be nicer to

22 people in general (including those from North Dakota).

24 Section 5: Every capable citizen in Montana shall spend half an hour each week picking up
25
26 garbage in a public place to decrease pollution and increase physical wellbeing.
27

28 Section 6: All schools and businesses in Montana shall recycle their recyclables.
29

30 Section 7: If a person is singing in a motor vehicle and three or more people also in the vehicle
31
32 ask the singer to stop singing, the singer shall stop immediately to increase the peace of the

34 general public.

36 Section 8: This bill shall go into effect upon passage.
