1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "ADDITION INTO THE CURRICULUM OF ALL
2 MONTANA HIGH SCHOOLS OF AN ELECTIVE THAT INCLUDES THE HISTORY OF
3 VAIRIOUS RELIGIONS"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 Section 1: All high schools must offer an elective that provides a brief history of the origin and
6 key points of multiple religions.

7 Section 2: No class will encourage any student toward conversion to any other religion

8 Section 3: Expense will be included in the school funding bill

9 Section 4: Text books about multiple religions would be made and used. They will have equal
10 number of chapters

11 Section 5: The content of the class will strictly be on the development of the religion, not on the
12 spirituality of that faith

13 Section 6: This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
