1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE DROP-OFF CENTERS NEAR
2 EVERY TOWN."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 Section 1: Every town in Montana is required to have a recycling drop-off center.

5 Section 2: Every town in Montana that has a population over 500 must have a place to drop-off
6 recyclable materials within the town's limits.

7 Section 3: Each of these centers must include a place to drop off paper, cardboard, soft plastics,
8 aluminum cans, tin cans, and glass.

9 Section 4: Each drop-off center must have a way to transport the recyclable materials to a
10 recycling plant.

11 Section 5: This bill will become effective on January 1st 2008.
