1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "SAVING MONTANA ONE SOLAR PANEL AT A  
2 TIME"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 NEW SECTION **Section 1. Action** You must be a United states citizen along with living in  
7 Montana you can install solar panel and change your house into solar and receive up to a \$5,000  
8 tax credit. A employment sector will be established to oversee the program

9 NEW SECTION **Section 2. Contest Rules** You must be a United States citizen and you must  
10 live in Montana. You must completely change your house over from electric to solar energy.  
11 You can only apply for tax credit once. With a new installation you may be able to apply again,  
12 the employment sector will decide. You must agree to a mandatory check and inspect service  
13 from the employment sector. This will be instituted to make sure your solar panel is installed  
14 and that you are suing your solar panel. You must agree to fill out any forms regarding the solar  
15 panels.

16 NEW SECTION **Section 3 Enforcement** This act shall be enforced by the Montana  
17 Legislatures and the Employment sector.

18 **Section 4 Fiscal Note** This funding for the act will come form the general budget and possible  
19 donations to fund for the Employees in the Employment sector.

20 **Section 5. Enactment Date** This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.
