1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "CLETUS...GIVE ME THE GUN"

2

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 WHEREAS the use of high powered assault weapons for hunting is not necessary for Montana
5 citizens, assuming they do not need 70 rounds to take down an elk and;

6 WHEREAS assault weapons have no practical purpose for "home defense", and are not a
7 "family weapon" and;

8 WHEREAS these weapons were designed for military purposes, not a method for a home
9 security system and;

10 WHEREAS the police and military forces of our state and country serve to protect against
11 anything requiring assault weapons.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED UPON BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
14 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE YMCA MONTANA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

15 Section 1: The possession and use of all assault weapons will be outlawed in the state of
16 Montana.

17 Section 2: Assault weapons are defined being characteristic of the following:

19 • A folding or telescoping stock

20 • A pistol grip

21 • A bayonet mount

22 • A flash suppressor, or threads to attach one

23 • A grenade launcher.

24 • Semi- or fully-automatic

26 Section 3: Exceptions will be made in the case of police and military forces.

27 Section 4: This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
