1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "An act to require all yellow lights to be extended by three  
2 seconds and be exactly the same length."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 NEW SECTION: SECTION 1: **Were will it apply to:** This bill will apply to all County's within  
7 Montana.

9 NEW SECTION: SECTION 2: **Enforcement of the bill:** This bill will be enforced by the  
10 Montana highway department and the city and district police.

12 NEW SECTION: SECTION 3: **Who will apply to:** This bill will only apply to Montana  
13 Citizens.

15 NEW SECTION: SECTION 4: **Reasons for this bill:** The reasons for this bill are quiet obvious.  
16 Every experience licensed driver with in Montana has experienced the fast and slow yellow  
17 lights. Now though we may not have all been caught running a red light we will eventually! So  
18 why deal with the random changing lights. This bill will not only make light timing exactly the  
19 same but also extend the caution light by three seconds. Not only will this allow safer flowing  
20 traffic but also it will give the hectic drivers a chance to relax when approaching a new yellow  
21 light.
