1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "An Immediate Revocation of No Child Left Behind"

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 SECTION 1: All guidelines of the No Child Left Behind Act should immediately be revoked as  
6 a means for determining federal funding for Montana school systems.

8 SECTION 2: Those schools whose scores were determined inadequate according to the  
9 standards of No Child Left Behind shall be re-analyzed for funding to go toward this  
10 approaching school year.

11

12 SECTION 3: Those schools whose test scores do not improve, but are at substantial levels shall  
13 be provided with sufficient federal funding.

14

15 SECTION 4: Schools should not be encouraged to "teach the test", and curriculum should not  
16 be based upon the state standards, but more upon a teachers passion to teach, and the desire of  
17 the students to learn. The current system IS counterproductive.

19 SECTION 3: This act shall be enacted immediately upon passage.
