1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ENFORCE RULES TO STOP OR LESSEN  
2 THE PROBLEMS OF BULLYING AND HAZING IN MONTANA HIGH SCHOOLS"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **Section 1. Purpose.** Enforcing and creating more rules to stop hazing and bullying in all  
7 Montana schools.

8 **Section 2. Specification for Rules.** Students will not be allowed to rough-house when  
9 not in the presence of a teacher. Students are not allowed to use cell phones, iPods, or other  
10 photo taking or electronic recording devices during school hours. Recording equipment will be  
11 used in the hallways to ensure no hazing/bullying is committed.

12 **Section 3. Punishment.** Individual Montana schools will enforce punishments of their  
13 choice.

14 **Section 4. Funding.** The state education fund will provide money for each school,  
15 depending on its size, to pay for all necessary recording equipment.

16 **Section 5. Effective date.** This bill will become effective at the beginning of the 2009-  
17 2010 school year.
