1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "REQUIRING SCHOOLS IN THE STATE OF
2 MONTANA TO INSTALL ESPRESSO MACHINES"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **Section 1:** Purpose: This bill will allow students access to caffeine in the morning so they are not
7 failing in school by sleeping.

8
9 **Section 2:** To inform schools about this bill, the state would send letters to all schools in
10 Montana. If after three months, the machines have not been installed, the superintendent will
11 install one himself/ herself.

12
13 **Section 3:** Funding: The General Education Fund would pay for the espresso machines;
14 however, the students would have to pay for the espresso to maintain the machines at the school.

15
16 **Section 4:** Volunteer students will run the espresso machines with payment of one free coffee
17 per shift, or school sanctioned clubs or athletic teams could take over the operation and
18 maintenance with profits going to the respective club or team.

19
20 **Section 5:** This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
