1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW A SPECIFIC AMOUNT OF HIGH  
2 SCHOOL CREDIT FOR APPROVED EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITES"

3  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **Section 1.** Purpose: To allow a specified amount of high school credit for approved  
7  
8 Extracurricular activates.  
9

10 **Section 2.** Definitions: Extracurricular activities being, any school organized group such  
11  
12 as sports, clubs, or any other recreational activities.  
13

14 **Section 3.** The approved extracurricular activities shall be approved by the school board.  
15

16 **Section 4.** These approved activities shall be deemed ½ credit.  
17

18 **Section 5.** A person shall not exceed 5 credits in their career, although students can  
19  
20 Participate in more than 10 activities.  
21

22 **Section 6.** In order to obtain the credit a person must be involved for the full length of that activity.  
23

24 **Section 7.** A person must also obtain at least a 2.5 GPA in order to receive credit.  
25

26 **Section 8. Effective date.** This bill will become effective upon the start of the next school

28 Year.
