1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL MONTANA SCHOOLS
2 MAINTAIN AND MAKE MANDATORY A PHYSICAL EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITY
3 PROGRAM FOR SIXTH THROUGH TWELFTH GRADES."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **Section 1. Definition.** Approved Extra Curricular Physical Activity Programs:
7 baseball, basketball, soccer, volleyball, gymnastics, dance, track, football, x-country,
8 walking club, karate, or hunting club.

9 **Section 2.** Extra curricular physical activities must occur 3 times a week for at least
10 one hour following a regular school day. Activities above last for one semester each.
11 Students may either take one per year or 2. If a desired physical activity program is not
12 listed above it must be approved by the 2008 Montana YMCA Youth Legislators.

13 **Section 3.** Participation in any school sanctioned sport for one whole season will count
14 as a credit for one semester of an extra curricular activity.

15 **Section 4.** Failure to participate in an extra curricular physical activity will result in
16 the student taking the year or semester they did not participate in over again or, if by their
17 choice, to take an approved extra curricular physical activity program during the summer.

18 **Section 5. Fiscal note.** Money to fund this act shall come from the General Fund.

19 **Section 6.** This bill will become effective at the beginning of the school year
20 following passage.
