A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "An Act To Have Any Woman That Is Going To Become Pregnant Should Have To Have a Test Which Says That They are Eligible To Be a Mother"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1: (Purpose) To prevent children from going to foster homes and having children abused at any age. A test that says a mother is willing to give the proper care that a child needs.

Section 2: (Enforcement) This act should be enforced through the Montana Legislatures.

Section 3: (Finances) This test will be paid through taxes that adults are required to pay

Section 4: (Date) This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.

Section 5: (Qualified) A woman is qualified to take care of child if she has a steady income and can provide the correct health care for the child. To determine if she would love her child and have compassion for her child.
