1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW TAX BREAKS FOR SMALL

2 BUSINESS START UPS IN MONTANA"

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 **Section 1.** Any small, first time business start ups, will not have to pay any state tax in  
5 the first five years.

6 **Section 2.** These Businesses must have fewer than fifteen employees. The business must  
7 be entirely owned by a Montana resident having lived in Montana for at least five years before  
8 starting up a business.

9 **Section 3.** This Bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.
