1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT RECRUITMENT BY ANY  
2 BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES WITHIN A MONTANA PUBLIC  
3 SCHOOL'S GROUNDS BY REPRESENTATIVES OR SPOKESMEN OF THE ARMED  
4 FORCES"

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

7  
8 **Section 1:** Purpose: To create a formal separation between the United States Armed Forces and  
9 the students of Montana's public schools.

10  
11 **Section 2:** Definition: Recruit – Verb: 1.) To secure the services of; 2.) To seek to enroll

12  
13 **Section 3:** All representatives of the United States Armed Forces will be prohibited from  
14 engaging in the act of recruitment within 100 yards of a Montana public school.

15  
16 **Section 4:** Information (i.e. pamphlets, posters) from the United States Armed Forces will be  
17 allowed within a Montana public school's grounds.

18  
19 **Section 5:** A fine of \$500,000 per recruiter will be issued per infringement of this bill.

20  
21 **Section 6:** This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.
