1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "HEALTHIER SCHOOLS"

 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 **Section 1. Vending Machine:** A machine that contains pop, sports drinks, milks, juices, and
 6 some snack foods.

7 **Section 2.** The vending machines in Montana Public Schools that sell food, drinks, and other
 8 items are to be shut off during classes. The machines can be turned on before school, during
 9 lunch, and after school hours. Other than the times stated the machines will be turned off or
 10 unusable. The schools may make the hours stricter. A school that follows shall be given a
 11 funding boost of an amount to be decided by the state superintendent of schools.

12 **Section 3.** A school failing to follow these rules will be assessed a fine of at least \$100 per
 13 student, or a punishment/fine decided by the state superintendent of schools.

14 **Section 4.** This bill shall become effective upon passage.
