1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "Required snowmobile/ATV license for Montana residents  
2 under the age of sixteen"

3  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 Section 1: Instructional classes will be offered by the state every fall with a driving test required before a

8 Section 2: The State of Montana all DMV's are required to issue snowmobile/ATV  
9 licenses to ages twelve and above.

10  
11 Section 3: Any Montana resident under the age of nine may ride on a snowmobile/ATV,  
12 but is not able to drive.

13  
14 Section 4: Any Montana resident over the age of sixteen may ride a snowmobile/ATV  
15 without taking a class required by the state.

16  
17 Section 5: Any Montana resident over the age of sixteen without a Montana driver's  
18 license is required to take an instructional class offered by the state to obtain a snowmobile/ATV  
19 license.

20  
21 Section 6: The instructional classes will be \$25 and instructors will be State certified  
22 volunteers.

23  
24 Section 7: Failure of Montana residents to own a Montana snowmobile/ATV license  
25 while operating a snowmobile/ATV will result in a \$100 fine. Failing a second time this will  
26 result in a \$200 fine. A third infraction will result in loss of license until the individual is sixteen  
27 years of age.

28  
29 Section 8: This bill will be effective starting January 2010 and will be enforced by the  
30 Montana FWP, Forest Service, and the Montana State Police.
