- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "School staff are permitted to carry firearms"
- 2
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:
- 4
- 5 Section 1: School staff is allowed to carry firearms on school property to protect themselves and
- 6 the students from a possible school shooting.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Students will still not be allowed to carry firearms or weapons on a school premise for
- 9 any reason.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: Any staff who wishes to carry a firearm must first pass the Montana Highway State
- 12 Patrol Firearms test before they are permitted a firearm.
- 13
- 14 Section 4: The firearms will be worn in a shoulder holster away from student contact.
- 15
- 16 Section 5: All firearms will be school owned and issued.
- 17
- 18 Section 6: All Firearms and ammunition will be purchased from government funding.
- 19
- 20 Section 7: All guns will be a 9 mm, semi-automatic hand gun.
- 21
- 22 Section 8: Guns and ammunition and supplies will be supplied at no cost to any staff member
- 23 that wants one.
- 24
- 25 Section 9: After the end of each day the firearms and ammunition will be stored in a locked gun
- 26 cabinet in the school safe in the school administrative office.

- 28 Section 10: If a shooting does occur a full government investigative report shall be conducted by
- 29 authorized government officials.
