1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE WORK FOR WELFARE
2 BENEFITS"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **Section 1.** Anyone receiving state welfare must work at a state job.

7 **Section 2.** The job will be provided by the state

8 **Section 3.** Anyone on Welfare Benefits has to work, even if the pay is at minimum
9 wage. If the citizen refuses to work, their benefits will be cut.

10 **Section 4.** The job is not necessarily there for the money, it is there for the citizen to be
11 part of the working society, as well as earn their benefits.

12 **Section 5.** Childcare will be provided by the state for anyone working welfare recipient.

13 **Section 6.** This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.
