1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "THE CREATION OF A THEORETICAL
2 (ALTERNATE) HISTORY CLASS AS AN OPTION IN MONTANA HIGH SCHOOLS."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 Section 1: Purpose: This class will allow for students in the Montana High School system to have
6 a chance to research and theorize on the possibilities on what if certain events were changed and
7 then evaluate new theories and events that may arise in the scenarios.

8 Section 2: Upon passing these classes would begin as an option for the 2009 to 2010 school year.

9 Section 3: These classes will be taught by either History or English teachers who wish to
10 volunteer to teach these classes.

11 Section 4: The Curriculum for these classes will consist of a mixture of research, theorizing,
12 writing, and the reading of modern books on the subject of Theoretical (Alternate) History.

13 Section 5: These classes will be funded by the General Education Fund.

14 Section 6: This bill will go into effect at the end of the 2008 to 2009 school year.
