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- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "NAP ROOMS WILL BE INSTITUTED INTO
- 2 MONTANA PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:
- 4 Section 1: A "nap room" will be created within every Montana high school that will give
- 5 students the option of taking a nap during their study hall.
- 6 Section 2: Homework assignments that are due must be completed by students before leaving to
- 7 use the nap room.
- 8 Section 3: These rooms will be basic with no desks but filled instead with blankets and pillows.
- 9 Section 4: A nap room "chaperone" will be placed within the nap room to watch students.
- 10 Section 5: If students choose to take a nap they must sign out of study hall, and then sign into the
- 11 nap room. Before leaving the nap room students must sign out and then sign back into study
- 12 hall.
- 13 Section 6: These sign out and sign in sheets will be compared by the respective teachers at the
- 14 end of the day.
- 15 Section 7: Students who abuse this privilege by not being in the class they have said they will be
- 16 in, or breaking school regulations and rules will be punished.

17 Section 8: A first offense will result in detention. A second offense will result in revoking the  
18 privilege of using the nap room and another detention.

19 Section 9: More than one nap room may be created based on the size of the high school.

20 Section 10: Funds for the costs of the nap room will come from the school budget. An increase  
21 in school budget will come from the general fund.

22 Section 11: If passed this bill will go into effect at the beginning of the next school year.
