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1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "To provide student education on Binge Drinking"

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

3 **Section 1:** Purpose: This topic will be taught in all high schools and college health classes in the  
4 state of Montana.

5 **Section 2:** This bill is to help more of Montana's youth understand the risks and dangers from  
6 binge drinking; this bill will offer information to the youth of Montana on subjects such as peer  
7 pressure, alternatives to binge drinking and the potential health risks involved.

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9 **Section 3:** Information: The curriculum for these classes will be as follows, the Culture of Binge  
10 Drinking, Health risks, Date Rape, and Statics on teenage Binge Drinking

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12 **Section 4:** Teachers will participate in in-service training or seminars on binge drinking, to gain  
13 and further their knowledge on the subject.

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15 **Section 5:** Funding: These classes will gain funding from MADD. (Mothers against Drunk  
16 Driving)

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18 **Section 6:** This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.

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
