A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE XIII, SECTION SEVEN OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO CHANGE THE DEFINITION OF A MARRIAGE"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1: Article XIII, Section 7 of the Montana Constitution is hereby repealed.

Section 2: Two-thirds vote of members required. Article XIV, section 8 requires a two-thirds vote of all members in the legislature for passage.

Section 3: Submission to the electorate. This amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2008 by printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the following:

() FOR repealing Article XIII, Section 7 of the Montana Constitution.

() AGAINST repealing Article XIII, Section 7 of the Montana Constitution.

Effective Date. The bill will become effective immediately pending the outcome of the election.
