14 **A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CHANGE THE ELEGIBILITY FOR A**  
15 **TRAFFIC EDUCATION LEARNER'S LICENSE. WITH AN EXCEPTION OF A FARMING**  
16 **PERMIT, TO CHANGE THE LEARNER'S LICENSE AGE TO 16 YEARS OLD.**

18 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:**

20  
21 **SECTION 1:** To change the eligibility for a Traffic Education Learner's License (TELL) from an early  
22 age of 14 ½ years old to at least 15 ½ years of age.

23  
24 **SECTION 2:** To provide an exception of a farming permit, used strictly for children on a farm  
25 environment, whose help are needed at an earlier age.

26  
27 **SECTION 3:** To change the law so that at the age of 16 a learner must still successfully complete a  
28 state-approved traffic education program.

29  
30 **SECTION 4: FISCAL NOTE:** the money that is already allotted for the drivers educational program  
31 will just be used in a different way. We will save money because drivers will be more educated.
