1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REPEAL 61-8-310, MCA SO TOWNS WITH  
2 POPULATIONS OF 750 OR LESS INSTITUTE A UNIFORM SPEED LIMIT OF 30 MPH."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 **Section 1. Action** Repeal 61-8-310, MCA.

6 NEW SECTION: **Section 2. Action** Institute a uniform speed limit of 30 miles per hour in towns with  
7 populations of 750 or less.

8 NEW SECTION: **Section 3. Enforcement.** The driver violating the 30 mph speed limit is to be charged  
9 \$30 over the original ticket price, or higher, depending on the amount the speed limit is exceeded.

10 Additionally, five points are to be assessed to the driver's record.

11 **Section 4. Fiscal Note** New town speed limit signs are to be installed by the enactment date and  
12 funded by the Department of Transportation.

13 **Section 5. Enactment Date** This bill becomes effective August 1, 2009.
