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1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: “AN ACT TO MAKE THE UNITED STATES  
2 ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY AND TO SLOW THE FILLING OF PUBLIC LAND FILLS.”

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

4 NEW SECTION **Section 1. Eligibility.** Any city in the United States that has a population of 500 or  
5 above will have the eligibility to be a part of the land fill project.

6 NEW SECTION **Section 2. Terms and Benefits.** These cities will be required to build recycling  
7centers and abide by mandatory recycling laws. Materials to be recycled will go in effect gradually.  
8The first year people will be required to recycle plastics. Upon the second year paper will be added,  
9and glass will be added the third year. Every citizen will obey these mandates or be subject to  
10penalties by law.

11NEW SECTION **Section 3. Fiscal Impact. Category Amount Description** Equipment \$20 million  
12Recycling plants, recycling bins to accompany trash receptacles. Labor \$10 million Annual salaries  
13for workers. Energy Resources \$20 million Annual expenses for plants. Marketing \$1 million  
14Informing public of the new legislation. Legal \$30 million Defense against any possible litigation.

15 **Section 4. Effective date.** This bill will become effective 6 month after passed.

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
