1. A BILL FOR THE ENTITLED: STUDENT SICK DAYS
2. TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF ILLNESSES IN SCHOOLS

4. BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATIVE

6. NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Prevent Attendance.** The purpose of this bill is to
7. prevent the spread of harmful illnesses in our schools.
8. NEW SECTION. **Section 2. The Guidelines.** A minor with a case of contagious illness that
9. may harm other students of a school, shall not be allowed to attend school till they are no longer
10. contagious. A doctor's order is need or the order of a nurse of the school to insure the student is ill and
11. contagious. This to insure a safe learning environment for students and to allow our students to perform
12. to the full potential. If a student does not provide the order or permission that student will not be
13. accounted for the attendance of that school day. That student will be subjected to **20-5-201. Duties**
14. **and sanctions** or the will of the school.
15. NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Costs.** The cost for this project will be about 3,000 to help
16. schools maintain the nurses and doctors to check off students. This will provide a reasonable amount to
17. monitor the attendance of students.
18. NEWSECTION **Section 3. Effective date.** This bill will be effective on August 25, 2009 before
19. the beginning of the 2009-2010 School year. To provide an effective system and paperwork to be provided
20. to the schools.
