A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "Montana Air National Guard Aircraft Upgrade"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Montana Air National Guard strike fighter planes are currently outdated and not comparable to other, foreign forces. Other countries currently deploy warplanes with twice the average thrust and higher maximum speed capabilities than the American F-15 and F-16.

Section 2. the American Air Force has contracted with American aerospace manufacturer Lockheed-Martin to use the multi-role, stealth technology F-22 Raptor. This plane is the highest technology available and the only fifth generation strike fighter jet available. No other foreign force can best the capabilities of this aircraft.

Section 3. Upgrading the speed, range, and in-flight capabilities of the Montana Air National Guard by changing all aircraft to the F-22 will decrease reaction times to any and all threats to the State of Montana and The United States of America. National disasters such as the horrific 9/11 could have been prevented if aircraft with the capabilities of the F-22 had been deployed at the first sign of conflict.

Section 5. Money to fund all replacements will be obtained by increases in State Income Taxes, deducted from all wages.

Section 6. Starting June 1, 2009 all outdated F-15 and F-16 jets will begin to be replaced. End all upgrades by January 1, 2011.
