1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "Hunting for handicapped"

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 **Section 1.** Hunting season should be expanded by 2 weeks at the end of the season for  
6 handicapped people. Handicapped people cannot go out and hunt just anytime during the  
7 season. They have to coordinate it with the people who help them. Two extra weeks would help.

8 **Section 2.** Currently general rifle hunting in Montana starts on October 21st and extends  
9 until November 25th, 2007 which is about 5 weeks. The handicapped season would be 7 weeks.

10 **Section 3.** This law would be regulated by Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks. The law  
11 should go into effect when the 2009 season starts.
