1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE WEARING OF SHUTTER  
2 SHADES WHILE DRIVING"

3  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

6 **Section 1.** Shutter Shades will not be worn while driving. They limit peripheral vision  
7 and hinder one's forward vision, thus creating a situation in which hazardous driving may occur.

8 **Section 2.** Shutter Shades will be defined as a facial accessory with any type of  
9 horizontal, vertical, or diagonal bars crossing through the lens portion of the shade.

10 **Section 3.** The wearing of Shutter Shades while driving will be seen as a primary offense  
11 and those who violate this law will be fined \$125 upon their first offense. One's previous fine  
12 will double upon every offense there after.

13 **Section 4:** The funds generated by the fines will go towards the building and rebuilding  
14 of Montana's roads.
