- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "REQUIRING ALL MONTANA PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO
- 2 ALLOW STUDENTS TO CARRY AND USE PERSONAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION
- 3 DEVICES (CELL PHONE, SMART PHONE, PERSONAL DIGITAL ASSISTANT, & ETC...)"
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:
- 5 **Section 1.** All Montana public schools shall be required by law to allow their students to carry and
- 6 use personal electronic communication devices (cell phone, smart phone, Personal Digital Assistant,
- 7 & etc...).
- 8 **Section 2.** All schools will teach appropriate phone etiquette and techniques of use to all students.
- 9 **Section 3.** Students will learn to properly and appropriately use and apply current technology
- 10 resources.
- 11 **Section 4.** Any school not in compliance will have one year from the time this bill goes into effect to
- 12 meet compliance.
- 13 **Section 5.** This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2009-2010 school year upon passage.
