1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO HAVE DRIVER'S EDUCATION  
2 PROVIDED IN MONTANA SCHOOLS YEAR ROUND"

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5  
6 Section 1: Schools will have to provide driver's ed to students all year round.

7  
8 Section 2: Many schools only have the driver's ed program during the summer. Many students  
9 work or go on vacation during the summer, and are limited on time. Many parents want their  
10 children to do driver's ed because it often lowers insurance.

11  
12 Section 3: This will allow students to be able to drive sooner even by going through drivers ed. It  
13 will make the streets of Montana safer since more students will have a chance to do driver's ed.

14  
15 Section 4: Students will still have to pay for the enrollment in driver's ed. The government and  
16 school will each have to pay 10% of the instructor's wage for each student. This will ensure that  
17 schools will be able to afford the program.

18  
19 Section 5: This bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
