1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "GETTING SCHOOLS TO GET MORE ACIVE IN
2 RECYCLING TO HELP MORE RESOURCES BE REUSED.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE

4 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Recycling Programs.** This Bill will ensure that all schools
5 will be required to have recycling programs to help and keep the United States cleaner then what it
6 is now.

7 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Recycling Guidelines.** The guidelines of this bill will be
11 declared that on Fridays that the recycling days when the recycling company comes and takes the
12 recyclables away.

13 (2) The students can bring the recyclables when ever they have any. All students will be
14 encouraged to take part in throwing anything that is recyclable in the recycling bins. Such as
15 newspapers, pop cans, bottles, and other objects that can be reused..

16 NEW SECTION **Section 3. Costs.** The Schools will not have to pay, they will be the
17 ones receiving money for their participation in the program. The recycling companies will drive to
18 to the school and take their recyclables and take them to their facilities to reuse them. The school
19 will receive the money for however much they make and use it for school funds for whatever they
20 want to use them.

21 NEW SECTION **Section 4. Effective Date.** This will will be in effect on April 25, 2009
22 to allow the school time to receive recyclables.
