14 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO MAKE RANDOM DRUG TESTING
15 MANDATORY FOR ALL STUDENTS IN HIGH SCHOOL"

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

19 **Section 1.** Government should implement a law to include all students in High School to
20 have a random drug test, not just athletes

21 --tests should be random with no prior knowledge to student body

22 **Section 2.** First offense after receiving positive results: in school suspension for a time
23 range specified by principal from 2 to 7 days, agreed upon within 48 hours of offense

24 **Section 3.** After first offense

- 25 1. student is tested in regular intervals twice a month
- 26 2. parents notified
- 27 3. has to pay fine of \$75; plus mandatory rehabilitation classes, paid for by
- 28 student

29 **Section 4.** In order to attend school again, one must pass a drug test 24 hours prior to re-
30 admittance in addition to passing the previous drug tests

31 **Section 5.** Second offense

- 32 1. expelled from currently attended school
- 33 2. police arrest, charged with illegal drug use and minor in possession- subjected
- 34 to change within state

35 **Section 6.** After second offense, drug results go on permanent record

36 **Section 7.** Offender must turn over prior drug results to new school

37 **Section 8.** Must have continual drug testing paid for by offender

- 38 1. once a month for first year following second offense
- 39 2. once every two months for second year after offense

40 **Section 9.** Effective date. This bill will become effective upon passage.
