3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

5 MCA 13-22-103

6 The secretary of state, in consultation with the superintendent of public instruction shall ~~solicit~~  
7 ~~county election administrators~~ and schools throughout the state to participate in the youth voting  
8 program. ~~The secretary of state and the superintendent of public instruction shall confer with~~  
9 ~~participating county election administrators and county superintendents of schools and, from~~  
10 ~~among interested schools, shall facilitate the participation of as many schools in the program as~~  
11 ~~available funds and other circumstances allow. A designated school may, at any time, decline to~~  
12 ~~participate by notifying the secretary of state in writing. Be entirely funded through private~~  
13 ~~donations.~~

16 The secretary of state, in consultation with the superintendent of public instruction shall require  
17 schools throughout the state participate in the youth voting program. Must be funded by 50% of  
18 general fund and 50% school districts funds.

20 MCA 13-22-107 funding

21 ~~(1) Except for compensation for time spent by employees of the secretary of state and the~~  
22 ~~superintendent of the state and the superintendent of public instruction, public money may not be~~  
23 ~~used to support or fund the youth voting program established in this chapter.~~

24 ~~(2)~~ (1) A nonprofit corporation may be formed subject to the provisions of Title 35, chapter 2, to  
25 solicit donations from private sources. Money solicited under this subsection must be used only  
26 for the youth voting program.

29 It will be effective by every state-wide election by 2010.
