- 20) 3) After the economic model is plead, we shall then allocate funding to state and regional contractors to begin
- 21) Construction on the plants as well as transportation routes that could be used for energy transoprt to out of state cu-
- 22) Stomers.
- 23) 4)Most important to realise is that public funding will be provided only if the cororations involved accept to give back
- 24) financial returns to the state by means of taxation of revenues and loan repayment as for the money provided will be
- 25) a relatively inexpensive loan with less that 1% interest and a 20 year payback period, however corporation can pay
- 26) sooner if they so choose.

- 29) The majority of the funding will be provided by the Federal government, , and will be latetr repaid by the overall
- 30) revenues generated by the taxation and savings earned back from inexpensive energy. (This doe not include the
