1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT ALL NEW HOUSES  
2 AND/OR BUILDINGS BUILT IN THE STATE OF MONTANA MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH  
3 CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE 2009 MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

7 **Section 1.** NEW SUB-SECTION TO MCA 50-60-201:

8 **Purpose of state building code.** The state building code must be designed to effectuate  
9 the general purposes of parts 1 through 4 and the following specific objectives and standards to:

10 (1) provide reasonably uniform standards and requirements for construction and construction  
11 materials consistent with accepted standards of design, engineering, and fire prevention practices

12 **Section 2.** While building a house and/or building, contractors will be required to install  
13 carbon monoxide detectors in that home or building.

14 **Section 3.** This bill will be enforced by health inspectors and police forces.

15 **Section 4.** This bill will need no funding, seeing as it will be included in the home  
16 owners bill from the contractors.

17 **Section 5.** This bill will become effective upon passage.
