1.A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO BE SMOKING IN
2.A MOTOR VEHICLE, WHEN THERE IS A CHILD OF, OR UNDER, THE AGE OF
3.14 YEARS OLD RIDING WITH YOU. ALSO, TO PENALIZE THOSE WHO ARE
4.IN VIOLATION OF THIS ACT."

5.BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

6. NEW SECTION. Section 1. Smoking in motor vehicle prohibited. (1) It is illegal
7.for the driver or any passenger in a motor vehicle to smoke a cigarette, a cigar, a
8.pipe, or any other light able products similar to these when a child who is 14
9.years of age or younger is also riding in the vehicle along with them. It does not
10.matter If the car is on private or public property, not does it matter if the
11.windows of the vehicle are rolled down.
12.(2) (a) The term "smoke," while used in this bill, refers to the inhaling,
13.exhaling, burning, or possessing any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or any other
14.light able substance similar to these in any form.
- 15.NEW SECTION. Section 2. Penalties. (1) Any driver that violates [section 1]
16.will be fined \$75.
17.(2) If a driver is in violation of [section 1], it cannot be recorded or charged against the driver's
18. record.
19.(3) An insurance company cannot increase the driver's premiums due to a violation of section 2
20.or hold it against them in any other way
