15 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW 'JUNK FOOD' IN MONTANA
16 PUBLIC SCHOOLS."

17
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

20 Section 1: All public schools that are funded by the Montana State Government will be allowed to
21 carry and sell foods that are of a high-calorie count and that are low in nutritional value.

22
23 Section 2: The Montana Senate Joint Resolution No. 2, passed Spring 2003 shall be amended to
24 meet the standards of which this bill contains. It previously regulated that schools shall rid
25 themselves of previously named 'junk food' and replace them healthier choices of which the
26 students are to choose from. Contrasting regulations and values of this bill shall be set under review
27 of the Senate to be either amended or disbanded.

28
29 Section 3: All funds gained through the vending and selling of said "junk food" shall be allocated to the
30 school and will be dispersed at the school's discretion.

31
32 Section 4: Enforcement of this bill will be through the Department of Education and the Department of
33 Health and Human Services.

34
35 Section 5: Any school in violation of this bill will result in the immediate cessation of ten percent of
36 their current allocated funds from the Montana State Government.

37
38 Section 6: This bill shall go in effect within the next school year, beginning in August 2010.
