14 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: AN ACT TO “CHANGE THE GRADE POINT WEIGHT  
15 OF COLLEGE CREDIT COURSES IN MONTANA HIGH SCHOOLS”

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

19 NEW SECTION Section 1. This bill adds section 20-7-13

20 NEW SECTION Section 2. 20-7-1301 all Montana high schools must uniform their  
21 grading system so that classes that are worth college credit are worth 110% of regular high  
22 school classes. The high school may define what a regular class is worth.

23 NEW SECTION Section 3. 20-7-1302 any Montana high school that does not comply  
24 will lose all state funding.

25 NEW SECTION Section 4. 20-7-1303 this bill will require no funding.

26 NEW SECTION Section 5. 20-7-1304 this act will become effective at the beginning of  
27 the 2010-2011 school year.
