14 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLE: "To Rid of Useless Excessive Finals and Tests"

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STATE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE

18 **Section 1.** There will be no more end of the semester finals or large tests in the high schools in
19 Montana.

20
21 **Section 2.** Subjects such as health, history and science will instead have small oral group
22 quizzes, such as jeopardy, at the end of each week to see if the information that was taught has been
23 retained. These will include information from the past weeks as well. At the end of each semester, there
24 will be a small multiple-choice test to make sure that the students understand the information for
25 science and health courses.

27 **Section 3.** For mathematical courses, there will only small written quizzes, in which students
28 can use their notes and work together. The students will not be able to copy, but can help each other
29 understand the information.

30
31 **Section 4.** For Literature, English, and Writing courses, students must write essays, but will be
32 able to take them home.

33
34 **Section 5.** For elective courses, such as art, physical education, and home economics, there will
35 be no tests. Participation will be the main factor of the students' grades.

37 **Section 6.** There will be no need for funding for this act.
