13 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW SENIORS IN HIGH SCHOOL TO
14 SERVE ON THEIR SCHOOL BOARD "

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

16 **Section 1.Action:** Every public high school in the state of Montana will hold elections
17 for two positions on the school board to be filled by members of the senior class. Only
18 members of the senior class will vote in these elections. In order to eligible for such a
19 position on the school board, a member of the senior class will need a cumulative GPA of
20 3.5 and be in good standing with his or her high school. After the student members of the
21 school board are elected, they will serve as members of the board with powers equal to
22 those of all other non-student members. Members will serve a term lasting one school
23 year, with elections held annually.

24 **Section 2. Funding:** No additional funding is necessary.

25 **Section 3. Effective Date:** This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2010-2011
26 school year.
