15 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO BAN BATTERY ELECTRIC CARS
16 FROM THE STATE OF MONTANA."

17
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE MONTANA YMCA YOUTH LEGISLATURE:

20 **Section 1: Plan.** No person shall be able to buy, sell, purchase, or drive a street-
21 legal vehicle that utilizes a battery as a source of engine power. Those who have
22 registered an electric street-legal vehicle before the passage of this bill may continue to
23 drive their vehicle.

25 **Section 2: Enforcement.** Any purchase of a battery electric vehicle will lead to
26 confiscation of the vehicle and a fine of \$500. Any attempt to register a battery electric
27 vehicle not registered before the passage of this bill will be denied. If a battery electric
28 vehicle is found not to be registered before the passage of this bill, it will be confiscated
29 and a fine of \$1000 will be administered. All enforcement will be carried out by the
30 Montana Department of Motor Vehicles in partnership with local law enforcement, if
31 need be.

33 **Section 3: Funding.** Any funding necessary for this bill will be provided by the
34 general fund.

36 **Section 4: Enactment Date.** This bill will go into effect upon passage.
