

The Super Dance Party Party (SDP)

A Party resolved to stand in moderation between Left and Right wing ideals in order to create the greatest degree of equality, liberty, and prosperity for the general public.

All beliefs of the SDP are outlined in detail below.

SOCIAL ISSUES:

Civil Unions, Gay Marriage etc: The SDP stands in firm support of Homosexual rights including, but not limited to, marriage, insurance benefits of couples etc. The SDP takes this stance because its members see that a denial of these fundamental rights is a blatant and deliberate infringement of these citizens' constitutional rights.

Abortion: The SDP is a pro choice party, however this pro choice stance is held until abortions are financed by the federal or state government. If the federal government were to pay for abortions, the SDP would take a pro- life stance, because as a political party the SDP believes that the government has no place paying to kill unborn children.

Education: The SDP strongly advocates the idea of a "level playing field," however the SDP believes it is the governments role only to provide the conditions that facilitate a level playing field. A level plating field allows the more motivated individuals to succeed.

Euthanasia: The SDP believes that in the case of a patient, being terminally ill and in a state of unbearable pain and agony should be given the option of euthanasia. However, like on abortion, the SDP is vehemently opposed to government funded euthanasia.

Healthcare: As a party the SDP does not endorse socialized or otherwise governmentally run healthcare program. The SDP, however, does believe the current system is corrupt, inefficient, and in need of fixing. We believe the government in cooperation with private insurance companies and other organizations need to work to reevaluate and renovate the current healthcare system, in order to create a new system that would be beneficial to the general public.

Death Penalty: The SDP strongly supports the death penalty, because such a punishment, when carried out quickly, saves taxpayer dollars. Furthermore capital punishment is an appropriate response to premeditated, unjustified, and deliberate homicide. The SDP advocates the nation, as well as individual states, to adopt faster death penalty procedures, preventing all manner of appeals that cost the system in money, time, and prison space.

Legalization of Marijuana: The SDP stands opposed to the complete legalization of Marijuana. The medicinal qualities of Marijuana are proven to be beneficial to patients undergoing chemotherapy etc. As such the SDP believes that MEDICAL marijuana should be made

available to those individuals undergoing medical treatment scientifically proven to be made more effective by the use of medical marijuana.

Drinking Age: The SDP believes that the legal drinking age should not be modified as the current drinking laws protect the development of youths. It is scientifically proven that the majority of development occurs before the age of 21. To a point the current drinking age prevents or discourages the consumption of alcohol in this vital time.

2nd Amendment Rights: Being a Montana founded political organization; the SDP is opposed to any attempts to limit gun rights outlined in the 2nd amendment.

The Economy:

General Economic Policy: As a party, the SDP advocates a Laissez Faire economic policy. That is, a policy that favors little to no government involvement in the economy, and leaves the economy to be guided by “the invisible hand” of free market competition. The party believes that government interference in the economy is undesirable as it causes the domestic economy to be more vulnerable to recession and serves to increase the federal deficit.

Government Spending: The SDP stands in vehement opposition to outrageous amounts of federal spending. A large federal deficit threatens the security of the nation, inhibits economic progress and development, and leads to an increase in middle class taxes. Furthermore, a budget deficit forces our government to borrow from other nations, thereby increasing foreign dependency.

Taxes: The SDP does not support any tax increases. If at all possible the SDP supports tax cuts.

Foreign Policy:

General Foreign Policy: When our nation is attacked, the SDP believes it is appropriate to adopt a zero tolerance foreign policy. This policy is advocated because it punishes those countries that may attack our nation and it acts as a powerful deterrent to further attacks.

In all other cases of foreign policy, the SDP strongly advocates an isolationist policy. This is done to limit aggression and hatred directed at our nation and the affairs of other countries is of no business to our nation. The only time when the SDP feels it is just to violate this policy is when the situation in question involves the violation of human rights (ei. genocide).

Immigration: The SDP advocates an open boarder policy. This policy is maintained assuming all possible immigrants enter the nation legally and proceed to become citizens. This involves the relaxation of immigration restrictions and citizenship requirements. The SDP believes that immigrants make up what is fundamentally “American”. In denying immigrants entrance to our country we deny our own cultural identity. In addition, immigrants are a vital part of the economy of our nation. The SDP does, however, believe that our boarders must be modernized and secured in order to prevent further illegal immigration. The Party holds that immigrants are an important facet of our society and culture.
